The tour included a visit to the shipping container restaurant on the top floor of the new Whole Foods in Midtown, Brash Coffee in the White Provisions development and Da Vinci's Donuts in the parking lot of Lenox Mall in Buckhead.

The **construction updates** for the Pittsburgh Yards campus are - (1) Tree installation on McDaniel Street is taking place, (2) Curb & gutter is currently going in on Ira Street and McDaniel, (3) Interior walls going up on South elevation of the building, (4) Exterior walls & sheathing completed on South elevation (5) West elevation is fully roughed-in.
