We Need Love: An International Exhibition Honoring Black Love is a groundbreaking exhibit that will explore Black love as a freeing force that is powerful, revolutionary, healing, unapologetic, proud, and unifying. The show opens from May 11th - June 8th at Pittsburgh Yards, a community-driven, mixed-use development, located in the Pittsburgh neighborhood of Atlanta.

The show features artists from across the diaspora whose work reflects layers of love: as celebration, as complicated, and as beautiful. Working within the mediums of photography, painting, sculpture, video, textile, and mixed media these artists peel apart self-love, romantic love, love for our communities, and love of our people.
